#### 1. RULES

2.4. Boats of different classes may be combined and scored using Portsmouth Yardstick at the sole discretion of the organiser.

#### 3. ENTRIES

3.1. Entries must be made on the Regatta website.

3.2. Entrants are requested to notify the organiser of their t-shirt size 5 days before registration.
