Official notices will be posted on regattaguru.com as well as at the SMYC. Changes to the SI may be communicated verbally on the water as described in the Standard Clauses. An 'L' flag may be flown to indicate that a change is being communicated.

## 6. Classes, Class flags, Race areas, and Order of starts:

### 6.1. Class flags:

Classes	Flag	Additional information
LSR	Green	LSR Boat Handling rules apply.
Laser, RS Vision	Laser	Both classes will start together but be scored separately.
Optimist Gold, Green	Opti	All Optimists will start together, but will be scored in fleets.

6.2. The race area and order of starts for the first start of each day will be posted before 0830 on each day of racing.

## 7. Scoring

A boats series score will be as described in the Standard Clauses (*one discard for every five races completed*).


## 8. Other rules:

- 8.1. Turns penalty: LSR: one turn. All other classes: two turns.
- 8.2. A White flag displayed over a class flag with two sounds means that any boat in that class still racing can choose to be scored in the position that they currently hold without completing the course or finishing. They can sail directly back to the start area to prepare for the next start. This changes Rule 28 and Appendix A4.
- 8.3. Prizes: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each Class.


